Hill of the same county and State as aforesaid stand before the sealing and delivering of these presents the receipt whereof I the said William N. Thomas do hereby acknowledge have granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said John R. Hill his heirs and assigns all the property herein after particularly mentioned that is to say my stock of groceries and dry goods on hand household and kitchen furniture one black horse blind in one eye, crop of Tobacco on the ground and now delivered up to the said John R. Hill bounded by the said William N. Thomas all and singular which said property are now in the possession of the said William N. Thomas. To have and to hold all and singular the property above bargained and sold or mentioned and intended to be to the said John R. Hill his heirs and assigns forever and I the said William N. Thomas for myself my heirs executors ^{and administrators} and assigns the said property unto the said John R. Hill his heirs and assigns against me the said William N. Thomas my executors administrators and against all and every other person or persons whatsoever shall and will warrant and forever defend by these presents of all and singular which said property I the said William N. Thomas have put the said John R. Hill in full possession by delivering him the said John R. Hill the whole of said property at the sealing and delivering of these presents in the name of the whole property hereby bargained and sold or mentioned or intended ~~to be~~ to him the said John R. Hill as
