Know all men by these presents that I Thomas Baldwin of Anne Arundel County and State of Maryland for and in consideration of the sum of ninety nine dollars current money to me in hand paid by Robert Plummer of Calvert County and State of Maryland at and before the sealing and delivering of these presents the receipt whereof I the said Thomas Baldwin do hereby acknowledge have granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said Robert Plummer his executors administrators and assigns all the articles herein after particularly mentioned that is to say all my interest in Crop Tobacco Corn and Wheat raised in Mrs Sarah E. Woods farm in the year 1851. all and singular which said Crop of Tobacco now hanging in one of Mrs Sarah E. Woods Barns and the corn set in the field and now in the possession of the said Thomas Baldwin. To have and to hold all and singular the said goods or crops of Tobacco corn and wheat and other the premises above bargained and sold or mentioned and intended to be to the said Robert Plummer his executors administrators and assigns forever and I the said Thomas Baldwin for myself my heirs executors and administrators all and singular the said crops and other the premises unto the said Robert Plummer his executors administrators and assigns against me the said Thomas Baldwin my executors and administrators and against all and every other persons or persons whatsoever shall and will warrant and defend by these presents of all and singular which said crops of Tobacco corn and wheat and other the premises I said Thomas Baldwin have put the said Robert Plummer in full possession by delivering him the said Robert Plummer one bushell wheat at the sealing of these presents in the name of the whole premises hereby bargained and sold or mentioned and intended to be unto him the said Robert Plummer as aforesaid. In witness whereof I have hereunto subscribed my name and affixed my seal this first day of October in the year of Our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty one.
