Know all men by these presents that I William Luthicum of Anne Arundel County in the State of Maryland for and in consideration of the sum of twenty five dollars to me in hand paid by George Waters of the said State and County at and before the sealing and delivering of these presents the receipt whereof I the said William Luthicum do hereby acknowledge have granted bargained sold and delivered and by these presents do grant bargain sell and deliver unto the said George Waters during his natural life and then to be free and discharged from all manner of servitude my negro woman Mary. To have and to hold the aforesaid negro slave above bargained and sold or mentioned and intended to be to the said George Waters during his life and then to be discharged from servitude And I the said William Luthicum for myself my heirs executors and administrators all and singular the said negro slave Mary unto the said George Waters during the time aforesaid against me the said Wm Luthicum my heirs executors and administrators and against all and every other person or persons what so ever shall and will warrant and forever defend by these presents In witness whereof the said Wm Luthicum have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this twenty first day of November eight hundred and fifty one
