

To have and to hold all and singular the said goods household stuff and furniture and other the premises above lay aimed and sold or mentioned and intended to be to the said John Basil Jr as attorney as aforesaid his executors administrators and assigns forever to his and their own use and behoof provided always and it is the true intent and meaning of these presents and of the said parties herunto that if the said Judson Stewart his heirs executors or administrators do and shall well and truly pay or cause to be paid unto the said John Basil Jr as attorney as aforesaid his executors administrators or assigns the said full sum of ninety seven dollars and fifty nine cents current money with interest for the same on or before the first day of January in the year eighteen hundred and fifty three without and deduction or abatement whatsoever then and from thence both these presents and every matter and thing therein contained shall cease and be utterly null and void any thing therein contained to the contrary thereof in any wise notwithstanding In witness whereof the said Judson Stewart hath hereunto set his hand and seal on this third day of December in the year eighteen hundred and fifty one.
