 justly indebted to the parties of the second part to their presents
 in the full and just sum of three thousand six hundred dollars
 current money and being anxious further to secure the same has
 agreed to execute their presents. And whereas John Roads of the
 County and State aforesaid on the second day of August eighteen
 hundred and forty five did by his deed of mortgage of that date for
 the consideration of the sum of two hundred and twenty dollars
 and fifty cents current money grant bargain and sell and convey
 unto him the said Papson McCulloch his Executors administrators
 and assigns all and singular the goods and chattels therein after
 named to wit all his interest in the crop of tobacco made last
 year at the farm on which he resided, called the Halfway House
 and also all his interest in the crop now growing on said farm
