 administrators and assigns a negro girl named Matilda aged  
 about two years and a negro boy named Henry aged ten years  
 slaves for life. To Have and To Hold the said negro girl and boy  
 unto the said Robert Welch of Ben his executors administrators  
 and assigns forever. Provided always and then presents are  
 upon this express condition that if the said Nicholas H. Green  
 shall well and truly pay or cause to be paid the said sum of  
 in the said note specified according to the terms and effects  
 the said note and shall also well and truly take up and discharge  
 all renewals of the said note or substitutes whether the same  
 be for the whole sum of three hundred and fifty dollars or any  
 part thereof then and in that said every matter and thing here  
 contained shall cease and determine and be utterly null and void  
 else to remain in full force and virtue in Law. In witness whereof  
 the said Nicholas H. Green hath hereunto set his hand and seal  
 the day and year first herein before written
