

which by acknowledgement has granted bargained and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto the said Lynch his Executors administrators and assigns one negro boy named Jacob Toogood who was fourteen years old on the thirteenth day of January last a son of a certain negro woman Kipp who with her increase was bequeathed by one John Boone of Wick to his daughter Charlotte Boone to serve her until they arrived at the age of thirty five years and thereafter severally to have their freedom no by reference to the last will and testament of John Boone of Wick dated twenty fifth day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and six recorded in Liber P. G. No 2 Folio 408 1/2 one of the records of the Register of Wills Office of Anne Arundel County will more fully appear To have and To hold the said boy a slave bargained and sold to the said Samuel D. Lynch his Executors Administrators and assigns until he arrives at the age of thirty five years to wit on the thirteenth of January in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty five and thereafter to be free
