Harwood of the same County and State aforesaid and before the sealing and delivery hereof the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge have granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said William B. Harwood his executors administrators and assigns A stallion named here called "Young Sam" said by "Sam Patch" of great renown who was a sure fold getter and a horse of great circus qualities. To have and to hold the same described property above bargained and sold to the said William B. Harwood his executors administrators and assigns forever to his and their only proper use and benefit. And I the said Thomas R. Beard for myself my executors and administrators shall and will warrant and defend.

Know all men by these presents that I Walter Pumphrey of Anne Arundel County and State of Maryland for the consideration of the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars current money to me in hand paid by Ellen Crane of the County and State aforesaid the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge have granted bargained sold and delivered and by these presents do grant bargain sell and deliver unto the said Ellen Crane my negro Girl Slave of a life name Caroline, which said Slave Caroline I will warrant and defend to the said Ellen Crane her Executors administrators and assigns against me my executors and administrators and against every other person or persons whomsoever.
