C. No 2 folio 408 one of the records of the Register of Wills office of Anne Arundel County will more fully appear. To Have and To Hold the said Boy aforesaid he gained and sold to the said James M. Lucas his Executors administrators and assigns till he arrives at the age of thirty five years and thereafter to be free in witness whereof the said Joshua Grimes the executor of Moses Lawrence has hereunto set his hand and affixed his seal this eighteenth day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty five
