presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have  
granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant  
bargain and sell unto the said Thomas Terry his Executors  
administrators and assigns one negro woman named Lucinda  
and a child Harriett about five years of age the former to  
serve until the first day of January in the year eighteen  
hundred and fifty and the latter for life. To Have and To Hold  
the said Negroes unto the said Thomas Terry his Executors  
administrators and assigns for the periods above limited. In  
Testimony whereof we have hereunto set our hands and affixed  
our seals this eighth day of September in the year eighteen  
hundred and forty
