Williams of sundry negroes dated the tenth day of October eighteen hundred and forty five } Know all men by these presents that I Editha Williams of the City of Annapolis and the State of Maryland for and in consideration of the sum of ten dollars current money to me in hand paid by John W. Williams of the City and State aforesaid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof the said Editha Williams do hereby acknowledge and of money paid and parcel thereof do hereby acquit exonerate and discharge the said John W. Williams his Executors or administrators have granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said John W. Williams his Executors administrators and assigns all those negroes which were conveyed unto the said Editha Williams by Bill of sale from Edward Williams bearing date the fifteenth day of April in the year eighteen hundred and forty four and recorded in Liber W. G. C. No 2 folio 324 one of the Record Books for Bills of sale for Anne Arundel County to wit Tom to serve for a term of years yet unexpired Stephen sometimes called Moses also to serve for an unexpired term of years a Boy Alexander a slave for life and a Girl Ellen also a slave for life. To Have and To Hold all and singular the said negroes according to their respective years of servitude hereby bargained and sold
