 and administrators do and shall well and truly pay or cause to be
 paid unto the said Barbara Lyles her executrix administrators
 or assigns the said full sum of one hundred and fifty dollars with
 legal interest for the same or before the fourteenth day of
 August eighteen hundred and forty seven then and from thenceforth
 these presents and every matter and thing therein contained shall
 cease and be utterly null and void any thing therein to the contrary
 thereof in any wise notwithstanding. In witness whereof I the
