

Bill of sale from Mary Linthicum  
to Rezin Hammond dated the 20<sup>th</sup>  
day of November 1845

Know all men by these presents  
that I Mary Linthicum of  
Baltimore County and State  
of Maryland for and in con-

sideration of the sum of one hundred and twenty five dollars lawful  
money of the United States in hand paid by Rezin Hammond of Anne  
Arundel County and State of Maryland aforesaid and before the making  
and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged  
Have granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain  
and sell unto the said Rezin Hammond his Executors administrators  
and assigns the following negroes viz my negro boy Charles aged four years  
to serve until the first day of June 1877 at which time the said negro  
Boy Charles if living will be thirty five years old and free from slavery  
my negro Boy George aged one year to serve until the 8<sup>th</sup> day of August  
1879 at which time the said negro boy George if he is living will be thirty  
five years of age and free from slavery. To Have and To Hold the said  
described negro boys Charles and George to the said Rezin Hammond  
his Executors administrators and assigns. And I the said Mary  
Linthicum for myself my heirs Executors and administrators the  
said negro Boys Charles & George unto the said Rezin Hammond his  
Executors administrators and assigns against me the said Mary  
Linthicum my Executors and Administrators and against all  
and every other person or persons whatsoever shall now will or hereafter  
come to whom hands and heels at this seventeenth day of  
November eighteen hundred and forty five
