Deed from William S. Green & wife
 to Robert Bowie dated the twenty

This indenture made this 28th
 day of January eighteen hundred
 and forty six between William S.
 Green and Matilda his wife of the

one part and Robert Bowie of the other part witnesseth that whereas
 various articles of personal property household and kitchen furniture
 now in the house occupied by the said William S. Green and Matilda
 his wife in Annapolis was purchased by means derived from the
 patrimonial estate of the said Matilda and otherwise as and for
 her separate personal estate or given to her for her advancement and
 whereas the said Matilda for the support of herself and family is
 now carrying on in said house the occupation and business of a boarding
 house and thereby earns and expects to earn future profits by her
 personal labor care and diligence now in consideration of the premises
 aforesaid the said William S. Green and Matilda his wife hath given
 granted conveyed and sold and by these presents doth give grant bargain
 and sell unto the said Robert Bowie all and singular the personal property
 household and kitchen furniture abovementioned and all such personal
 property as may hereafter be purchased for the said Matilda out of
 her patrimonial estate or the interest or profits hereof or by the earnings
 of her labor and care as aforesaid or acquired in any other mode of her
 personal or separate means and particularly any and every estate and
 interest acquired by or through or with means derived from her patrimonial
