Hall the following property to wit some negro boy named Daniel one negro girl named Lane three beds Bedsteads Bedding two carpets eighteen chairs four tables one Bureau one clothes press two stoves and kitchen furniture now in possession of Mrs. Margaret Hall. To Have and to hold the above described property to the said Benjamin H. Hall his Executors administrators and assigns and to his and their only proper use and behoof and to no other use intent or purpose whatsoever. In Testimony whereof I have hereunto subscribed my name and affixed my seal this 4th day of April eighteen hundred and forty five
