To Have and To Hold the same described property abovesaid bargained and sold to the said Robert B Chew his Executors administrators and assigns forever to his and their only proper use and benefit and I the said John Alquehart for myself my Executors and administrators shall now will warrant and forever defend by their parents to the said Robert B Chew his Executors administrators and assigns the said described property against me my Executors and administrators and against all and every other person or persons who or shall claim or to claim the same in any part thereof. In Testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal the twentieth day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty six.
