about forty years, about five feet five and one
half inches high of a dark complexion with a
small scar upon the right cheek and another
scar upon the right eye, with the first joint of
the little finger of the left hand stiff, is the same
person manumitted by Daniel of Saint Thomas
Juniper by deed dated the fourteenth day of April
in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred
and ninety and that his freedom commenced on the
first day of January in the year one thousand seven
hundred and ninety two, and that the said Bill Porter
was raised in Charles County
