 Given the 29th day of Oct. 1812.

Maryland, Anne Hundel County to wit: I hereby certify to all whom it doth or may concern that it hath been proved to my satisfaction that the bearer hereof a negro man named William aged about thirty years of a dark complexion about five feet three inches high with a large scar over the forehead and another small scar over the nose, is the same person manumitted by James Glenn Drury by deed dated the ninth day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and five and that his freedom commenced on the twenty fifth day of December in the year Eighteen hundred and ten, and that the said Negro man named William was raised in the County aforesaid
 Given the 13th day of November 1812

Maryland Anne Hundel County to wit: I hereby certify to all whom it doth or may concern that it hath been proved to my satisfaction that the bearer hereof a negro man named Stephen of a dark complexion about five feet four and a half inches high with a scar upon his upper lip aged about twenty five years is the same person named in a deed of manumission executed by Joseph Selby on the fifth day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety two and that his freedom commenced on the twenty fifth day of December one thousand eight hundred and twelve and that the said negro man Stephen was raised in the County aforesaid
