 certify to all whom it doth or may concern that it hath
 been proved to my satisfaction that the bearer hereof a
 blackman named William Smith aged about twenty
 three years about five feet eight inches high of a
 brown complexion and marked in the face by the
 small pox is the same person manumitted by Samuel
 Hannum by deed bearing date the seventeenth day
 of January in the year of our Lord one thousand
 seven hundred and ninety one, and that the said
 William Smith was raised in the City of Annapolis
