I hereby Certify to all whom it doth or may concern that it hath been proved to my satisfaction that the bearer hereof a negro man named James Fisher aged about twenty one years about five feet seven inches high of a brown complexion with a small scar over the left eye and another on the right cheek bone, was free born; and that the said negro man James Fisher was raised in the County aforesaid
