To all whom it may concern, be it known, That I Mary Callahan of Ann Arundel County, in the State of Maryland for divers good causes and considerations me thereunto moving, as also in further consideration one hundred Dollars current money, to me in hand paid, have released from Slavery, liberated manumitted and set free, and by these presents do hereby release from Slavery, liberate, manumit and set free, my two negro women Rachel and Lucy and the said two negro women, I do declare to be henceforth free manumitted and discharged, from all manner of servitude or service to me, my executors or administrators forever.
