To all whom it may concern, be it known that I
Augustine Gambrell of Ann. Arundel County, in the
State of Maryland, for divers good causes and
considerations me therunto moving have released
from slavery, liberated, manumitted and set free
and by these presents do hereby release from
slavery, liberate, manumit and set free my
negro woman named Elinor and her the said
negro woman named Elinor I do declare to be
henceforth free manumitted and discharged
from all manner of servitude or service to me
my executors or administrators forever. In Witness
whereof I have herunto set my hand and affixed
my seal this seventeenth day of March Eighteen
Hundred and Three -
