

To all whom it may concern, Be it known,
that I Randolph Brandt Latimer of the City of Annapolis
in the State of Maryland, for divers good causes and
considerations me thereunto moving, as also in
further consideration of one dollar current money
of the United States of America, to me in hand
paid, have released from Slavery, manumitted and
set free, and by these presents do hereby release
from Slavery, liberate, manumit, and set free
my negro woman, named Piss, being of the
age of about Thirty three years, and has but one
Leg, but able to work and gain a sufficient
livelihood and maintenance, and her the said
negro woman named Piss, I do declare to be
henceforth free manumitted and discharged from
all manner of servitude, or service to me, my
heirs executors, or administrators forever. In
Testimony whereof, I have hereunto set my hand
and affixed my seal this sixth day of April in
the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred
and Three.
