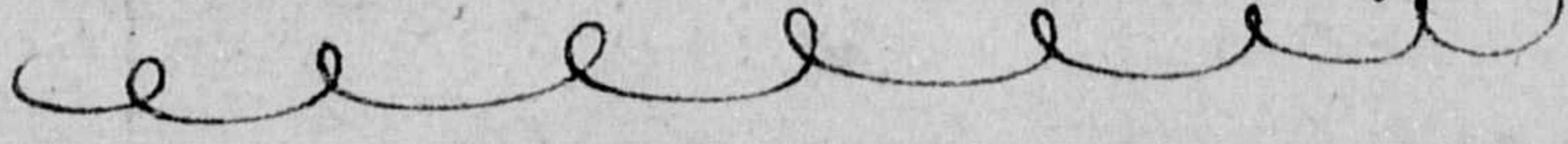

Mary Tidout Ann Arundel County to wit, know all to Charity Folks I Men by these presents that I Mary Tidout of the County aforesaid in the State of Maryland for and in Consideration of the faithful Services and dutiful behaviour of my mulatta Slave named Charity Folks do hereby liberate manumit and set free the said Charity from the date of these presents and for myself and my heirs do hereby forever quit claim to all servitude from her and as a further reward to said Charity Folks I do hereby manumit liberate & set free her female Child named Hannah immediately and her son named James Jackson I do hereby manumit liberate and set free from and after the first day of January which shall be in the year of our Lord
