


Know all men by these presents that we Nicholas

whereof we have hereto set our hands and seals the
twenty third day of August eighteen hundred and four.

and four, Nicholas Brewer and Sarah his wife severally
acknowledges the foregoing Instrument of writing to be
their act and deed before me a Justice of the peace
for Anne Arundel County.

Exam^d I John Roger Howard of the County of Baltimore
and State of Maryland do hereby set free from
bondage my negro man named Charles aged about
fifty eight years, also my negro woman named Tal or
Sarah wife of the said Charles aged about fifty four
years the said Charles and Tal formally belonged
to the estate of Samuel Howard of Anne Arundel
County deceased, and do for myself my executors
and administrators release unto the said Charles and
Tal respectively all my right and claim whatsoever
as to their persons or to any estate he or she may
