To all whom it may concern, Be it known, That I Randolph
 Prandt Latimer of the City of Annapolis in Anne Arundel
 County in the State of Maryland for divers good Causes
 and Considerations mo^{re} thereunto moving, as also in the fur-
 -ther Consideration of one Dollar Current ^{money} to me in hand paid
 Have released from Slavery, Liberated, Manumitted & set
 free, And by these presents, I do hereby Release from Slavery
 Liberate manumitt and set free the two following Slaves to
 wit, Negro Sarah aged about eighty years and Negro Ben-
 jamin of about the age of Forty one, or two years, & fully
 able & Capable to work & gain a sufficient Livelihood &
 Maintenance, and them the said Negro Slaves, named
 Sarah and Benjamin, I do declare to be henceforth free
 manumitted and discharged from all manner of Servi-
 -tude, or Service to me my Heirs, Executors or Administrators
 forever. — provided Nevertheless, and it is my Ex-
 -press intention that the said Negro Man named Benjamin
 as aforesaid, shall not be entitled to his Freedom, unless he takes
 great Care in feeding & Cloathing his Grand Mother named
 Sarah as aforesaid, and who is entirely devoted to him, & she
 I manumitt to please, Him and Her, and to ascertain this
 Request of my friend Mr. Walter Boswell of Charles County
 to judge and as soon as he finds her neglected, then the
 said Negro man ~~Benjamin~~ Benjamin is to return into my
 Service if I am living, but this not to take place unless Mr.
 Boswell gives from under his hand, that of his own
 Knowledge, the said Negro man Benjamin, has not
 treated his Grand Mother well. I do.
