ents do hereby release manumit & Set free my negro Child named
Mary Ann, daughter of my negro Woman Hanny, of the age of two-
ty months, and as the said Mary Ann I do declare to be hence-
forth free manumitted & discharge & from all manner of servitude or
service to me my Executors or Administrators forever. In witness
whereof I have hereunto set my hand & affixed my seal this nine-
teenth day of February eighteen hundred & five
