

from Bondage my negro Woman named Floret, aged about thirty years, and do for myself my Executors & Administrators release unto the aforesaid Negro Woman named Floret all my right Title and claim to her as a Slave Declaring her to be absolutely free from me or any persons claiming by thro or under me, In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this twenty fourth of July in the year eighteen hundred and five
