To all whom it may concern, be it known that I  
 Richard Dorsey of Anne Stundel County, in the State of  
 Maryland, for divers good causes and considerations me there-  
 unto moving, as also in further Consideration of the sum of  
 Seventy Dollars current money to me in hand paid, have  
 released from Slavery, liberated, manumitted and set free and  
 by these presents, Do hereby release from Slavery, liberate,  
 manumit and set free, my negro Woman named Pipp  
 otherwise called Presilla, who is able to work and gain  
 a sufficient livelihood and maintenance, and let the  
 said negro Woman, named Pipp alias Presilla, do  
 declare to be henceforth free, manumitted & discharged  
 from all manner of Servitude or Service to me, my Executors  
 or Administrators forever — In Testimony whereof  
 I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my Seal, this  
 Nineteenth day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand  
 eight hundred & five
