Now this Indenture Witnesseth that the said George Hogarth in pursuance of the said agreement and bargain and Sale hath manumitted and set at liberty and hereby doth manumit and set at liberty the said man Slave Edward Brown And the said George Hogarth for himself his Executors and administrators doth hereby release and disclaim all right title and interest in and to the person labours and services of the said Edward Brown. In Witness whereof the parties hereunto have set their hands and seals Signed Sealed and delivered by the above named George Hogarth & Araminta Harrison in the presence of us
