(To all whom these presents shall come
greeting J. Ferringham Drury of Anne Arundel County, for
divers good Causes and Considerations mo^t thereunto moving
declare free, manumit, liberate and Enfranchise the
following Negroes, To wit, (Flora aged about thirty two years
to be free on the first day of September eighteen hundred and
fifteen, and in case Flora should have any children
during her servitude they shall be free when they arrive
to the following ages viz. Males at the age of twenty five
and females at twenty one and her children's children
to the latest generations in like manner, in a former
manumition I Liberated a Negro Dinah and I now
declare Dinah's children's children to the latest generation
to be free. Males at the age of twenty five and females at
twenty.
