 John Price Junr of the City of Annapolis, being fully per-
 suaded that all men are born free & equally entitled to the
 enjoyment of their Liberty do hereby by these presents
 emancipate & set free from ~~me~~ my heirs, Executors and
 Administrators, the following Slaves who shall be free
 at the expiration of the periods herein after mentioned ~~My~~
 Phill, a mulatto & Lib, a black, now living with my
 son John Price Jr shall be free on the fifteenth day
 of April Eighteen hundred & twelve, Letty now in
 Frederick with Mr Jeremiah Morning, Eliza & Kitty
 Gray, children of Dinah Gray, shall be free as
 follows - Letty at the expiration of Seventeen years to be
 computed from and after the fifteenth day of the present
 month Eliza & Kitty from and after this date
