Whereas J. Seth Sweetser of the City of Annapolis in Anne Arundel County and State of Maryland for divers good causes and considerations me thereunto moving, do hereby declare free, manumit & enfranchise my Negro man named George Martin Jr (being about the age of (Twenty one years) on the twentieth day of March Eighteen hundred and fifteen hereby acknowledging the said Negro man George Martin discharged from all claims of Service and right of property whatever from me, my heirs, Executors & Administrators from the said twentieth day of March Eighteen and fifteen, Witness my hand and Seal this 28th day of April 1806
