free from bondage the following Negroes purchased
by me of John Callahan and Mary Mann Viz: Negro
Woman Rose on the twenty fifth day of July one
thous and eight hundred and two Negro Girl
Hitty on the twenty fifth day of July one thous and
eight hundred and seven and Negro girl Harriett
on the twenty fifth day of July one thousand eight
hundred and twenty five also the Negro Girl Poll
whom I purchased at Col. Crews Sale of Negroes
who is aged about nine years and six months
on the twenty fifth day of January one thousand
eight hundred and fourteen and likewise the
Negro Woman named Rose that I bought of Eleanor
Davidson Executrix of John Davidson this present
day And I do for myself my Executors & Administrators
release unto the Negroes aforesaid all my rights & Claims
whatsoever as to their persons or to any Estate they
may acquire after the Dates to each person respectively
