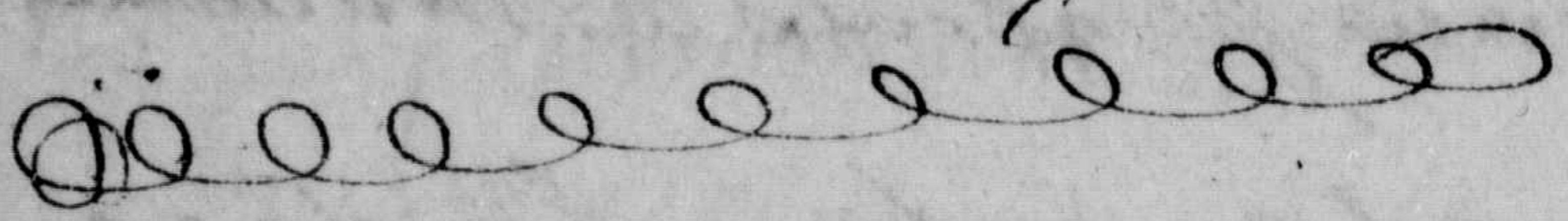


in the year one thousand eight hundred & one

Recorded 13<sup>th</sup> August 1806



To all whom it may concern, Be it known that I  
d. d. James Boothe of Anne Arundel County and State of Maryland  
for divers good causes and considerations me thereunto moving  
as also the further consideration of twelve pounds ten  
shillings and three pence current Money, to me in hand paid  
have released from Slavery, liberated, manumitted and set  
free, and by these presents do hereby release from Slavery  
liberate, manumit and set free, my negro man named Henry  
Boote being of the age of forty years, and able to work and  
gain a sufficient live lihood and Maintenance, and him the  
said negro man, named Henry Boote I do declare to be  
henceforth free, manumitted and discharged from all  
manner of servitude or service to me, my Executors or  
Administrators or Assigns forever. In Testimony

whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my Seal  
this nineteenth day of August in the year of our Lord one  
Thousand Eight hundred and six
