

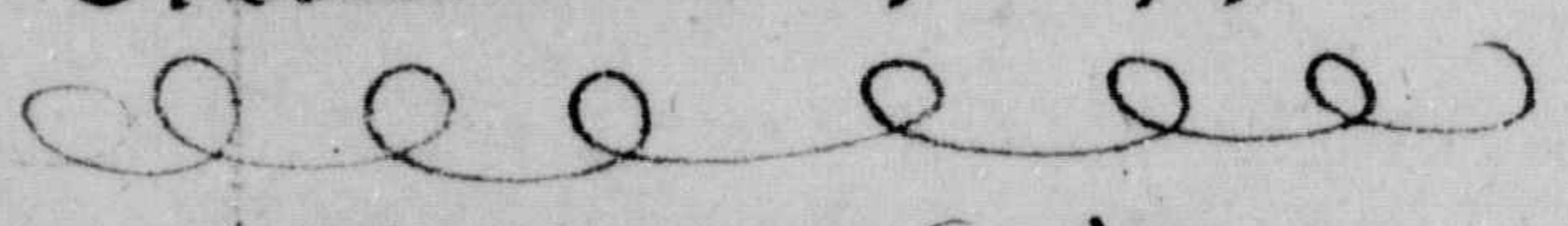

Bayan Williams of Ann Arundel County within the State of
Maryland for divers good Causes & Considerations
in the unto moving do hereby Declare free manumit
and Infranchise the Negroes following to wit, Negro
Sad Peerer aged about sixteen years to be free the
third of November eighteen hundred & fifteen a Negro
had named Andrew aged about thirteen years to be
free November the third one thousand eight hundred &
eighteen hereby Declaring the said Negroes Discharged
from all Claim of Service and right of property whatever
from me my heirs Executors Administrators on the date above
mentioned as witness my hand and seal this ninth day of
October one thousand seven hundred & ninety eight
