To all whom it may concern, Be it known, that I Richard Weedon of Anne Arundel county in the state of Maryland, for divers good causes and considerations me thereunto moving, as also in further consideration of five dollars current money to me in hand paid have released from slavery, liberated, manumitted and set free; and by these presents do hereby release from slavery, liberate, manumitt and set free, my negro woman named Judda or Judda being of the age of about forty years, and able to work and gain a sufficient livelihood and maintenance, and her the said negro woman named Judda or Judda, I do declare to be henceforth free, manumitted and discharged from all manner of servitude or service to me, my executors or administrators forever.
