Negro Charles presents that J. C. Weems of Ann Arundel
County in this State of Maryland do hereby manumit set
free and discharge from any service and the service
of all persons claiming under me a Negro Man whose
name is Charles aged thirty six years to be free on the
fifteenth day of October which will be in the year of
our Lord eighteen hundred and I do hereby for myself
and all persons claiming under me release and
discharge the said Negro Man Charles from all
claim of Slavery after the time above specified In
Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal
this first day of November one thousand seven hundred
and ninety eight
