Know all men by these presents that I John Chees
Thomas of Anne Arundel county and state of Maryland
do hereby manumit and set free my mulatto woman
slave named Bett aged about thirty years wife
of negro James late the property of Major Thomas
Snowden deceased, I do also hereby manumit and
set free her four children named and aged as follows
to wit, William aged about eight years, James
aged about 5 years Sarah aged about three years
and Thomas aged about one year. In witness
whereof I have hereunto set my hand and
seal this 30th day of March 1807.
