 I Nicholas Harwood clerk of Anne Arundel County Court do hereby certify that it appears by a deed of Manumission from Mary Hopkins to negro Candias of the County aforesaid bearing date on the first day of April Seventeen hundred and eighty two and recorded amongst the records of Anne Arundel County Court aforesaid that freedom was thereby granted unto a negro woman stated then to be of the age of seven years, which said freedom was to take place when she arrived to the age of eighteen years. -

I further certify that a negro woman named Candias now present and who has made application to me for a certificate of her freedom, has proved by testimony which is satisfactory to me, that she is the identical person who was manumitted by the above mentioned deed of manumission, the said negro woman Candias is about five feet six inches high & appears to be about thirty two years of age, her complexion dark, and was raised at the head of Souths river in the County aforesaid. -
