I Nicholas Harwood clerk of anne arundel county court. Do hereby certify, that it appears by a deed of Manumission from Daniel of S. Thomas Senfer — bearing date the fourteenth day of April seventeen hundred and ninety and recorded amongst the records of anne arundel county court that negro Salt aged about twenty three years was to be freed in the year Seventeen hundred and ninety six; she is about five feet three inches high her complexion a dark brown, was raised in anne arundel county. Smith Puel of said county made oath before Gideon White a Justice of the peace for the county aforesaid that the said negro Salt is the identical person mentioned in the said Manumission. —

I Nicholas Harwood clerk of anne arundel county court. Hereby certify, that a negro man named Benjamin Baager who is now present, and who has made application to me for a certificate of his freedom has proved by testimony which is satisfactory to me that he is free born. The said Benjamin Baager is about five feet six inches high, appears to be about twenty two years of age, his complexion is a very dark brown, and was raised at the head of south river in the county aforesaid. —
