 Annapolis and had at the time of her death several
 Children and among others the following (that is to say)
 Abigail now about twenty years of age of a yellowish
 complexion, Lucy about eighteen years of age and nearly
 of the same complexion Harry about fifteen years of
 age of a dark complexion and who has a scar of a
 burn on his right arm. Bazar about sixteen years
 of age also of a dark complexion and who has a
 scar on her forehead on the side of her head, and
 Sal about twelve years of age also of a dark
 complexion and has a scar on her right hand.
