date of the manumission. She is about five feet three
inches high her complexion black was raised in the County
of Anne Arundel. Sarah Edwards of Anne Arundel County
made oath before Joseph Sands a Justice of the Peace
for the County aforesaid that the said Lydia is the
identical person who was mentioned in the said deed
of manumission
