was freeborn, the said Bathaine Prout is about
five feet two inches high, and appears to be
about the age of forty one years, her complexion
is a mulatto and was raised at the head
of South river in Anne Arundel County aforesaid.
She is very much marked in the face occasioned
by the small pox. —
