among the records of Anne Arundel County Court, that
negro girl Barbara aged about sixteen years was to
be free from the day of the date of the said deed of
manumission, she is about five feet two inches high
her complexion a bright Mulatto, was raised in the
County of Anne Arundel, Edward Holland of Anne
Arundel County made oath before Joseph Sands
a Justice of the peace for the County aforesaid that
said Barbara is the identical person who was set
free and mentioned in the said deed of manumission.
