Shubby Certify that it appears by a Deed of Manumission from Richard Darrell to Negro Benjamin James aged about twenty two years bearing date the twenty sixth day of December one thousand eight hundred and five and recorded among the records of Ann Arundell County Court that the said Negro Benjamin James was to be free from the date of the said Manumission that he is about five feet ten inches and a half high his complexion yellow was raised at Portland Manor on Patuxent River in Ann Arundell County - James Darrell of Ann Arundell County made oath before Gideon White a Justice of the Peace of the County aforesaid that the said Negro Benjamin James is the identical person mentioned in the said Deed of Manumission
