arrive at the age of twenty one year that she is about
five feet one inch and a half high her complexion black
was raised on South River in the County of said Samuel
Macrabbin made oath before John Brine a Justice of
the peace for said County that the said Negro Dinah is
the identical person mentioned in the said Deed of
Manumission - Spent 12 May 1806.

complexion black was raised on Herring Bay in the County
of said William Whittington of said County made oath before
Gideon White a Justice of the peace for the County &c.
that the said Negro Ben is the identical person
mentioned in the said Deed of Manumission.
