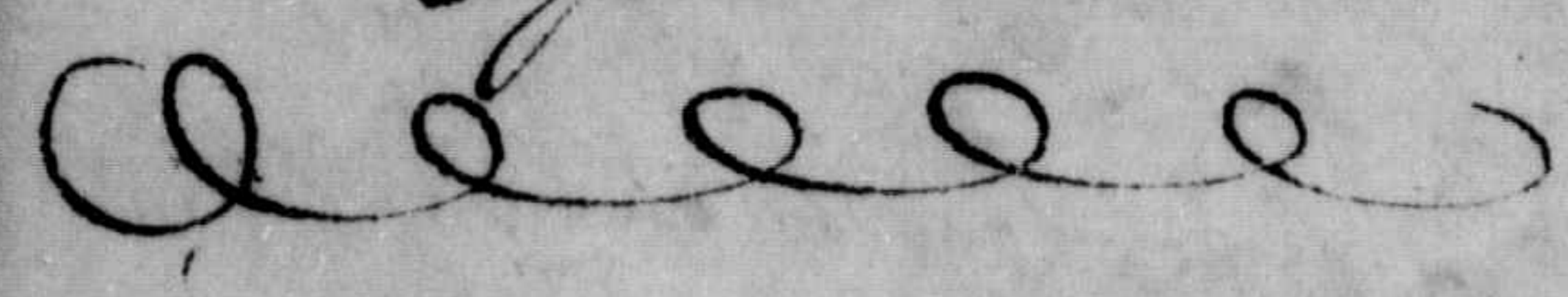


William Weems to Sunday Negroes bearing date the
