 named Camilla aged about thirty five years at this time
 was to be free from the date of the said Manumission she is
 about five feet two and a half inches high her complexion
 Yellow was raised on herring bay in Anne Arundel
 County, James R. Mays of said County made oath
 before Gideon White a Justice of the peace for the County
 aforesaid that the said Negro woman named Camilla is the
 identical person mentioned in the said deed of Manumission
