bearing date the nineteenth day of October Seventeen  
hundred & ninety two and Recorded amongst the  
Records of Ann Arundel County Court that the said Negro  
Robbin was set free on the twenty seventh day of December  
one thousand eight hundred and five that he is about  
the age of twenty one years of this kin is about  
five feet nine inches high his complexion black was  
raised on Severn River in the County of said Richard  
Montkin of said County made oath before Gideon  
White a Justice of the peace for the County of that  
the said Negro Robbin is the identical person  
mentioned in the said Deed of manumission at the  
same time the said Negro Robbin made oath  
before the said Gideon White that he has lost his  
Certificate of freedom but for granted him
